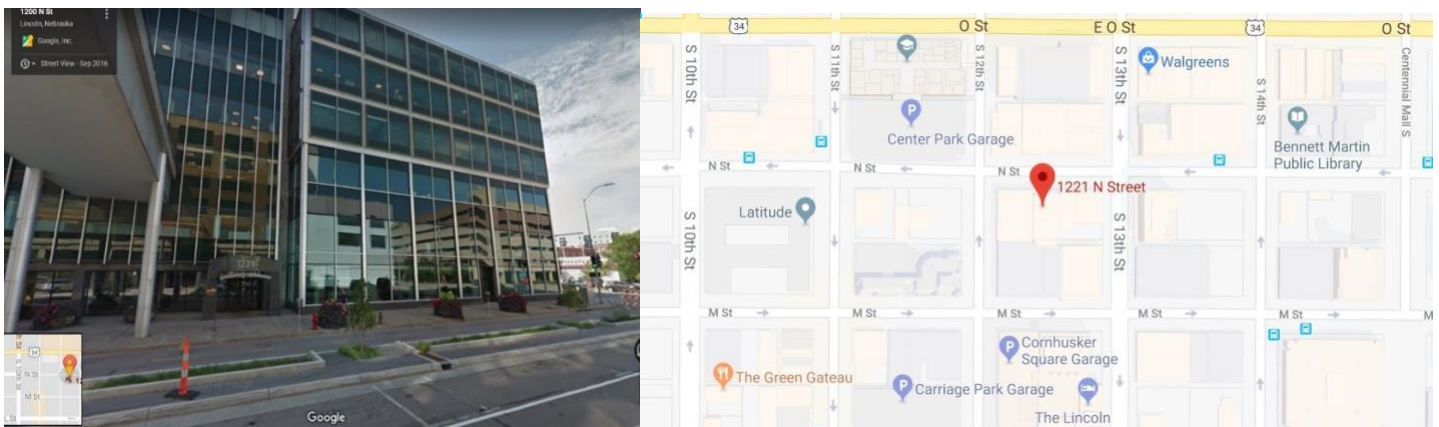

Those offices are next to each other at 12th and N Street in downtown Lincoln. As you head west on N Street, the building is located on the left hand side, about two blocks past the Bennett Martin Library. Great Western Bank is just east of that location at 1235 N Street. The purpose of this move is to accommodate upgrades in the State Capitol related to the HVAC project. Relocation of the Secretary of State divisions to 12th and N Street will be long term. The Records Management Division remains housed at 440 S Eighth Street, Suite 210, south of the Haymarket.
