**Business entity reports can be filed online**

LINCOLN – Nebraska Secretary of State John Gale says that required reports for business entities can be filed online with his office.

Biennial reports of limited liability companies, biennial reports of nonprofit corporations and annual reports of limited liability partnerships are due April 1. An entity that fails to file its report and pay the fee will be dissolved, Gale said.

The reports can be filed online at <http://ne.gov/go/business>. Payments for the online filings may be made by credit card or electronic check.

Business entities still have the option of filing a paper report.

“Entities should enjoy the convenience and ease of filing online,” Gale said. “Online filing also has the benefit of easing the paperwork handled by my office.”

The reports are used for the office’s database so the public has updated information on business entities.
