Watson qualifies as U.S. Senate candidate for general election

LINCOLN – Another candidate has qualified to be added to the ballot for U.S. Senate in Nebraska. Secretary of State John Gale says more than 4,000 signatures have been verified for Todd Watson.

Watson reported submitting 5,380 signatures. The threshold for being included on the ballot is 4,000, with at least 750 of those signatures collected in each of Nebraska's three congressional districts.

Watson and Jim Jenkins, both independent candidates, will be listed on the ballot as 'by petition'. Republican Ben Sasse and Democrat David Domina advanced in the primary election.
