New members start terms on Nebraska State Records Board

LINCOLN – Secretary of State John Gale administered and signed oaths for two new members of the Nebraska State Records Board during a meeting Wednesday, August 6. Sec. Gale serves as chairman of the 12-member board.

Crystal Wichita and Brenda Ealey were appointed by Governor Dave Heineman and will serve a three-year term, with the possibility of being appointed to serve an additional three-year term.

Wichita is chief information officer for Cornhusker Bank and replaces Ryne Seaman as a representative of the banking industry. Brenda Ealey is the manager for Gere Branch Library in Lincoln. She replaces Julie Beno as a representative for the public libraries in Nebraska.
