### **Sec. Gale: Election fraud unit is on standby**

LINCOLN – Secretary of State John Gale says his election fraud unit is on standby, should the need arise. Anyone can call his office on Election Day to express a concern and make a formal complaint if appropriate.

“Rest assured, if the complaint is found to be credible, it is passed along to the proper authorities for consideration and action,” said Gale.

All calls are confidential. Election Division staff members are trained to take down the appropriate information for follow up.

“In each statewide election, there are many calls for which satisfactory answers can be given, as well as a modest number of formal complaints logged with my office. Each report is reviewed. If the complaint is determined to be legitimate, it is forwarded to the proper election official or to local, state or federal law enforcement agencies.”

The number to call is toll free (888) 727-0007. Additionally, voters can call the Elections Division directly at (402) 471-2555.

“If something is amiss at the polling place, or there’s a concern that some type of voter fraud is taking place, we want to hear about it,” reiterated Gale. “The goal is to make sure all issues are handled in an appropriate and lawful way.”
