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### **Sec. Gale reminds corporations: Your biennial reports are soon coming due**

LINCOLN – Secretary of State John Gale is putting the word out to thousands of domestic and foreign corporations doing business in Nebraska – your biennial reports are soon coming due. The deadline is March 1. Gale said that approximately 30,000 letters will be mailed from his office reminding those business entities that the absolute last date to file is April 15.

Failure to file the necessary reports and pay the associated fees can lead to the administrative dissolution of the domestic corporation or in the case of the foreign corporation, having the certificate of authority revoked.

"Users can go straight to the main page of the website and click on the appropriate link to reach the correct form. Anyone in need of assistance can call the Business Services Division of my office at 402-471-4079."

Currently, there are 41,432 domestic corporations registered in Nebraska and 12,730 foreign corporations. So far, just over 24,000 corporations have filed their paperwork with the Secretary of State's office. The majority of those reports, 75 percent, have done their filing online.

This is also the filing period for nearly 500 limited liability partnerships (LLPs) also registered in the state. Annual reports from those entities are due by April 1 and are delinquent June 1.

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
