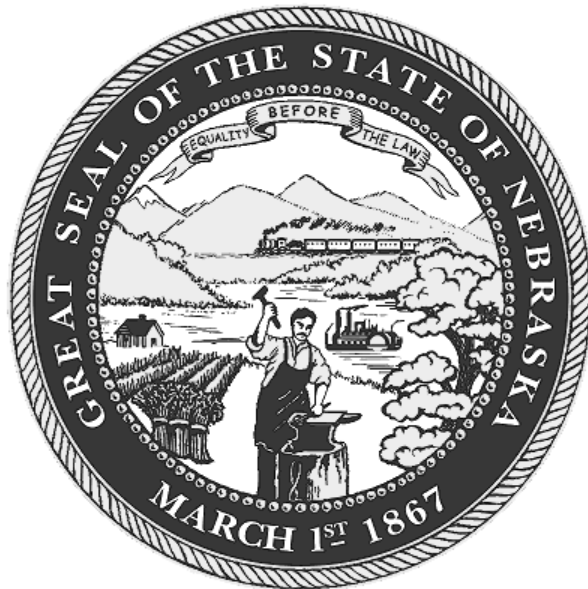

## **Reported Problems**

### **Buffalo County**

Some Collins Precinct ballots were intermixed with Center Precinct ballots in the Center Precinct polling supply box. Collins Precinct ballots were mistakenly voted by 49 Center Precinct voters. The ballots for the precincts were identical except for Legislative District 36 which appeared on the Center Precinct ballot only. Legislative District 36 was uncontested with only one candidate. As a result, no outcomes were impacted.
