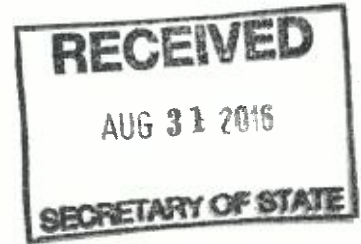

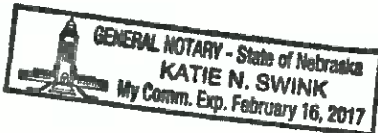

Nebraska Cannabis Initiative Petition

**To add a new section 26 to the existing Article XV of the
Constitution of Nebraska**

Proposed Constitutional Amendment Language:

(1) Any person in the State of Nebraska shall have the right to use any plant in the genus Cannabis and any of the parts of such plant in the State of Nebraska.

(2) The right to use any plant in the genus Cannabis and any of the parts of such plant shall include, but not be limited to, (a) noncommercial personal possession, consumption, manufacture, and distribution by persons twenty one and older, (b) commercial possession, consumption, manufacture, and distribution, and (c) noncommercial personal possession and consumption by a person under twenty-one years of age with written permission from a parent or legal guardian and a written recommendation from a licensed health care practitioner.

(3) Any law that interferes with the application of this section shall be considered null and void. Nothing in this section shall allow a person to engage in conduct that endangers others.

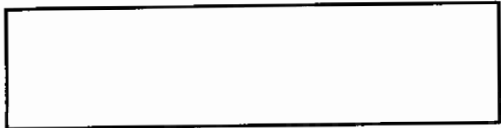
(4) If any portion, clause, or phrase of this section is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining portions, clauses, and phrases shall not be affected, but shall remain in full force and effect.

Object Clause

The object of the Nebraska Cannabis Initiative Petition is to amend the Constitution of Nebraska by adding a new section 26 to Article XV which states that any person in the State of Nebraska shall have the right to use any plant in the genus Cannabis and any of the parts of such plant in the State of Nebraska.

Amend the Constitution of Nebraska by adding a new section 26 to Article XV which states that any person in the State of Nebraska shall have the right to use any plant in the genus Cannabis and any of the parts of such plant in the State of Nebraska.

To the Honorable John Gale, Secretary of State for the State of Nebraska:

We, the undersigned residents of the State of Nebraska and the county of _____, respectfully demand that the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be referred to the registered voters of the state for their approval or rejection at the general election to be held on the 6th day of November 2018, and each for himself or herself says: I have personally signed this petition on the date opposite my name; I am a registered voter of the State of Nebraska and county of _____ and am qualified to sign this petition or I will be so registered and qualified on or before the date on which this petition is required to be filed with the Secretary of State; and My printed name, date of birth, street and number or voting precinct, and city, village, or post office address are correctly written after my signature.

WARNING TO PETITION SIGNERS-- VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS OF LAW MAY RESULT IN THE FILING OF CRIMINAL CHARGES: Any person who signs any name other than his or her own to any petition or who is not qualified to sign the petition shall be guilty of a Class I misdemeanor. Any person who falsely swears to a circulator's affidavit on a petition, who accepts money or other things of value for signing a petition, or who offers money or other things of value in exchange for a signature upon any petition shall be guilty of a Class IV felony.
