

2008 Candidate Filing Deadlines

Primary Election

If a candidate for an elective office is an incumbent, the filing deadline for the 2008 primary election is Feb. 15, 2008. All other candidates shall file by March 1, 2008.

Incumbent shall mean a person who holds an elected office, either through election or appointment, and is filing for that office or a different office. No incumbent who resigns from elective office prior to the expiration of his or her term shall file for any office after Feb. 15, 2008.

General Election

If a candidate for an elective office is an incumbent, the filing deadline for the 2008 general election is July 15, 2008. All other candidates shall file by Aug. 1, 2008.

Incumbent shall mean a person who holds an elected office, either through election or appointment, and is filing for that office or a different office. No incumbent who resigns from elective office prior to the expiration of his or her term shall file for any office after July 15, 2008.

The following offices are contested only during the general election: township office, village board of trustees, reclamation district, weed district, small public power district (annual gross revenue of less than \$40 million), Class II school district board, learning community coordinating council and educational service unit board.
