


**SWORN STATEMENT**

- 1. Statutory initiative designating use of tax receipts derived from casino gambling, with more than 90% of such tax receipts assisting K-12 Schools in Nebraska.







**OBJECT STATEMENT**

To authorize the exclusive uses of tax receipts from state authorized casino gambling, namely to provide financial support for K-12 education in Nebraska, the Nebraska Gaming Control Board, the Compulsive Gamblers Assistance Fund, and the State Racing Commission.

**A BILL**

FOR AN ACT relating to exclusive uses of tax receipts from state-authorized casino gambling; specifically to provide financial support for K-12 education in Nebraska, the Nebraska Gaming Control Board, the Compulsive Gamblers Assistance Fund, and the State Racing Commission; and to define terms.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. (1) For the purposes of this section:

- (a) State-authorized casino gambling means the casino gambling authorized under the Constitution of Nebraska;
- (b) K-12 education means elementary and secondary education in Nebraska;
- (c) Tax receipts from state-authorized casino gambling means the funds received from the gaming tax imposed on state-authorized casino gambling;
- (d) Nebraska Gaming Control Board means the regulatory agency having authority over licensed casinos in Nebraska;
- (e) State Racing Commission means the entity created under section 2-1201; and

- (f) Financial assistance means funds provided to K-12 education by means of any program provided by the Legislature.
- (2) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, tax receipts from state-authorized casino gambling provided for by the Constitution of Nebraska shall be used exclusively for the following:
- (a) The first seven hundred fifty thousand dollars annually shall be transferred to the Nebraska Gaming Control Board for its operations;
  - (b) After the transfer in subdivision (a) of this subsection, the next three million dollars annually shall be transferred to the Compulsive Gamblers Assistance Fund established pursuant to section 71-817;
  - (c) After the transfer in subdivisions (a) and (b) of this subsection, five percent of the remaining tax receipts, not to exceed ten million dollars annually, shall be transferred to the State Racing Commission to enhance the purse offered for live horseracing in Nebraska; and
  - (d) After the transfers in subdivisions (a) and (b) of this subsection, a minimum of ninety-five percent of the remaining tax receipts shall be used to provide financial assistance in the manner determined by the Legislature to K-12 education.
