


SWORN STATEMENT





OBJECT STATEMENT

The object of this petition is to create the Nebraska Gaming Control Board, consisting of seven voting members, to license and regulate state authorized casino gambling in this State.

TEXT OF INITIATIVE

A BILL

FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Gaming Control Board; to create the Nebraska Gaming Control Board.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. (1) The Nebraska Gaming Control Board is created and authorized to (a) regulate all aspects of state-authorized casino gambling provided for under the Constitution of Nebraska, (b) license appropriate applicants to operate one or more casino gambling facilities, (c) establish such rules and regulations as the board deems necessary and proper for the licensing and regulation of state-authorized casino gambling, and (d) charge licensing fees for applications for licenses and for the issuance of licenses to successful applicants. The board shall issue or deny an application for a state-authorized casino gambling license within one year of submission of the application.

- (2) The Nebraska Gaming Control Board shall be comprised of the following seven voting members: The Attorney General; the Secretary of State; the Commissioner of Education; and four additional members appointed by a majority of the three state officers as follows: One serving, elected mayor from each congressional district as the districts existed on January 1, 2006, and one at-large member. The at-large member shall not be a serving, elected official at the time of appointment or during his or her term of service on the board. Each member who is an elected official shall serve for the same term on the board as the member serves in the applicable elective office. The at-large member shall serve for a term of four years and is eligible for reappointment, but shall serve no more than two consecutive terms.
