The testing of all eligible applicants will be held on the third Wednesday of each month at 10:00 AM, in the Nebraska State Capitol Building room 1305. Applicants who are interested in taking the test should contact the Secretary of State's Office at (402) 471-2385 prior to taking the examination.

When obtaining your Surety Bond, it would be in your best interest to obtain one that does not expire until the end of the licensing period. All licenses are required to be renewed by June 30 of each even numbered year.
