Chapter 8 - HEARING EXAMINERS.

001 Selection and Qualifications. Hearing Examiners to conduct public hearings upon a complaint of a discriminatory public accommodations practice or practices shall be selected by the Commission pursuant to such standards and methods for selection as the Commission may determine.

002 Compensation. Hearing Examiners shall be reimbursed by the Commission for their expenses necessitated by conducting such hearings.

003 Disqualification. Any Hearing Examiner may, after being designated by the Commission to conduct a public hearing upon a particular complaint, disqualify herself or himself from conducting such public hearing, by written request to the Commission stating that she or he feels unable to conduct a fair hearing; and upon receipt of such written request, the Commission shall select another Hearing Examiner to conduct the public hearing on said particular complaint, and shall promptly advise all parties, by registered or certified mail, of the name of the person so selected as Hearing Examiner.
