#### Chapter 2 - TEACHER AND ADMINISTRATOR CERTIFICATE REINSTATEMENT PROCEDURE

#### 001 General Information

<u>001.01 Statutory Authority</u> Section 79-869 of the Revised Statutes of Nebraska (R.R.S.) requires that the Professional Practices Commission adopt rules and regulations for the performance of its functions as set forth in Section 79-859 through 79-871 R.R.S.

001.02 Scope and Application of this Chapter This Chapter contains the procedures used by the Commission to hold hearings and make recommendations to the State Board of Education concerning reinstatement of revoked public school certificate(s) of certified employees holding public school certificates pursuant to Section 79-868 of the Revised Statutes of Nebraska and Chapter 27 of title 92 of the Nebraska Administrative Code.

<u>001.03</u> Related Regulations Standards of professional practices and ethics for holders of both public and nonpublic school certificates are contained in 92 NAC 27. Procedures for hearings in public school certificate cases are contained in 95 NAC 1. Procedures for investigation in all cases and hearings in nonpublic school certificate cases are contained in 92 NAC 28. Regulations for the issuance of public school and nonpublic school certificates are contained in 92 NAC 21. Regulations for the reinstatement of former nonpublic school certificate holders are contained in 92 NAC 29.

<u>001.04</u> <u>Definitions</u> The following definitions shall apply herein:

<u>001.04A</u> Petitioner - Any individual filing a petition seeking a reinstatement of a revoked public school certificate.

001.04B Board - The Nebraska State Board of Education

<u>001.04C</u> Commission - The Nebraska Professional Practices Commission

001.04D Commissioner - The Nebraska State Commissioner of Education

holder=s certificate for a certain period of time. At the expiration of the period of Ineligibility fixed by the Board, the former certificate holder may apply for reinstatement in accordance with this Chapter.

<u>004.04F</u> Respondent - The Nebraska State Commissioner of Education.

#### 002 The Petition

<u>002.01</u> Filing - Upon expiration of the time period fixed for revocation by the Board, an educator whose public school certificate has been revoked may file a Petition with the Commission for reinstatement of his or her certificate.

<u>002.02</u> Form of Petition - The Petition shall comply with Rule <u>002.02A</u> through <u>002.02G</u> and be prepared in substantially the form set forth in Appendix A. Upon filing of the Petition with the Commission, the case shall be assigned a case number.

<u>002.02A</u> The venue shown as ABEFORE THE NEBRASKA PROFESSIONAL PRACTICES COMMISSION®

002.02C The name and address of the Petitioner;

<u>002.02D</u> The caption APETITION FOR REINSTATEMENT@under the case number;

<u>002.02E</u> A statement that AThe undersigned Petitioner for reinstatement of a revoked Nebraska teaching, administrative and supervisory, or special services counseling public school certificate alleges: (a)

<u>002.02E1</u> Petitioner shall set forth the type, rank, level, endorsement, and expiration dates of the certificate(s) revoked, and his or her social security number.

<u>002.02E2</u> Petitioner shall set forth the Final Decision of the Board revoking the certificate(s).

<u>002.02E3</u> Petitioner shall set forth the name(s), address(es), phone number(s), and date(s) of employment for all employers of Petitioner During the period of certificate revocation. If unemployed for three months during any time period, set forth your activities during that time period.

<u>002.02E4</u> Petitioner shall set forth the name(s), address(es), and phone number(s) of all witnesses, including Petitioner, that will testify on behalf

#### Of Petitioner at the hearing.

<u>002.02F</u> A statement indicating that the Petitioner has fully complied with the Order of Revocation that he or she will not in the future engage in any practice which is listed in the statutes as grounds for revocation or suspension of a certificate, and that he or she is familiar with the criteria of professional practices adopted pursuant to 79-868.

<u>002.02G</u> The Petitioners signed, dated, and notarized affirmation that the statements in the Petition are true, correct, and complete to the best of his or her knowledge and belief.

<u>002.03</u> <u>Service</u> The Petition shall be filed with the Commission and a copy of the Petition shall be served upon the Commissioner by certified mail, return receipt requested.

#### 003 Investigation

<u>003.01</u> Commencement of Investigation Upon receipt of the Petition for Reinstatement, the Commissioner or his or her designee may investigate the Petitioner in order to determine if the Commissioner wishes to contest the Petition for Reinstatement.

<u>003.02</u> <u>Objection to Reinstatement</u> If the Commissioner contests the Petition he or she shall file an answer to the Petition with the Commission within thirty (30) days from the date the Petition was filed and served on the Commissioner, setting forth the grounds for objection.

<u>003.03</u> <u>Uncontested Reinstatement</u> If the Commissioner does not contest the Reinstatement Petition, he or she shall forward either a written recommendation in support of the Petition or a written document with no recommendation to the Commission.

#### 004 Hearing

<u>004.01</u> <u>Notice of Hearing</u> The procedures for notice and appointment of a hearing panel shall be conducted in accordance with the procedures established in 95 NAC 1, not in conflict with this Chapter.

<u>004.02</u> Conduct of Hearing The hearing shall be conducted in accordance with the procedures established in 95 NAC 1, not in conflict with this Chapter.

004.03 Burden of Proof The burden shall be upon the Petitioner to prove to the

Commission that he or she meets all certification requirements in force at the time of application.

<u>004.04</u> Evidence The receipt of evidence shall be in accordance with the procedures established in 95 NAC 1, not in conflict with this Chapter.

<u>004.05</u> <u>Disposition of Cases</u> Disposition of the case shall be in accordance with the procedures established in 95 NAC 1, not in conflict with this Chapter.
